






17 years old young lady


- Paracentesis twice a week

Since the socioeconomic status of the patient and his family was not good, a team from our center visited the environment where the patient would live after discharge.

At the end of the examination, they reported that it would not be safe for the patient to live there. About 8 people lived in a 2-room house and the bathroom and toilet were located outside the house.


The patient's family was contacted and allocated a house next to the hospital and the patient started living in this house. She was also employed as a secretary in the transplantation service. At that time, the patient was only a secondary school graduate and had no work experience. She was supported with education and experience by our center.



Just 8 months later, in **September 1991**, the patient was bred with a beautiful wedding.








November 1993

Two years after marriage, the patient became pregnant. She was closely followed during pregnancy and no complications occurred. She gave birth to a healthy baby boy in 1993
