- I assumed responsibility for the innovative and successful, monthly audiovisual teleconferences, initially as part of the capacity-building activities of our Pediatric Renal Sister Center pair initiative between Montreal and Bangalore, which has now expanded to include all mentioned Sister Renal Centres.
