Shri Dilip Prabhakar Deshmukh was born on September 15, 1961 in the state of Maharashtra. After completing his graduation, he joined Rashtriya Swayamsewak Sangh (RSS) as a full timer (Pracharak). During his tenure in RSS, he worked during plague epidemic in Surat city and Earthquake in Kutch District of Gujarat. In RSS he devoted more than 20 years. Since the year 2004 he has spent maximum of his time in Kutch where he is mentoring a secondary school in rural area Named "BBM Highschool Bidada, Kutch". Through the path of education, he tried to increase the ratio of Girls education and he mentored many youths to take leadership in the field of Politics, environment, rural development, social upliftment etc.

in January 2020 he Suddenly diagnosed with liver cirrhosis. On 10th July 2020 his liver transplant surgery was done at Institute of Kidney Disease and research centre (IKDRC)-Gujarat university of Transplantation sciences. He got liver donation through cadaveric organ donation of a young college student of Surat, Gujarat. After recovering from the surgery, he decided to devote his maximum time in the society to bring awareness about cadaveric organ donation. His aim is to bring waiting list for organ transplant at zero in Gujarat. For this noble cause he is travelling up to the blocks and village level of Gujarat. He started this Movement in June 2021 as "Angdaan Mahadaan Abhiyan".

As a part of organ donation awareness, he wrote a book of his own pain and organ transplant experience named "Third inning: My liver transplant voyage". This book has been Printed in Gujarati and English languages. There are more than 20000 copies of this book has been distributed without any cost in the society.

After That book he published two more books which have stories of Organ donor families. These books are playing vital role during the organ donation counselling of patient's relatives at ICUs.

Simultaneously with the organ donation awareness campaign he is encouraging people to live healthy life and save the organs. He is taking care of Post transplant and pre transplant patients as well as Family members of the diseased organ donors through his NGO.


